RULES AND REGULATIONS:

SHOWS: All shows are sanctioned by the American Goat Society, and its rules shall govern. The sponsoring organization is the American Goat Society. All goats must be registered with the American Goat Society, American Dairy Goat Association, or the Canadian Goat Society. ALL BLUE PAPERS ACCEPTED TO SHOW. The base dates for computing animals' ages are June 4 (AGS National Youth Show), June 5 (AGS Junior Does and Bucks) and June 5 (AGS Senior Does), 2010.

ENTRY FEES: All entries must be on official entry forms. To be eligible for regular entry fees, entries must be postmarked on or before May 25, 2021, and must be accompanied by all entry and other fees. No entry fees are required for Showmanship in the National Youth Show, but you **MUST** have a regular entry in the Youth Show. No fees are required for Group Classes. Entries postmarked after May 25 and received by June 1 will be accepted, but must be accompanied by an additional late fee of \$10 per animal per show. No entries past this date, post entries, or telephone entries will be accepted. Make check payable to Midwest Caprine Collective. Checks returned NSF will incur a \$30 fee. All entry forms and fees should be sent to Jennifer and they will be entered. No entries will be considered official until entry fees have been received.

HOW TO ENTER: Send a printed copy of the official entry form, with your check for all fees or your credit card number can also be paid via PayPal to midwestcaprinecollective@gmail.com or by Venmo. Mail to: Jennifer PARRISH, PO BOX 303, Oquawka, IL 61469

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions may be made within the show only. Exhibitors wishing to substitute animals must do so before or at check-in. Substitutions made before May 31st are free of charge. There will be a \$5.00 charge for each substitution made after that date, either by e-mail or message.

CHECK IN:

The original registration certificate is required for animals over 6 months of age; stamped duplicates are acceptable for animals under 6 months of age. Proof of animal's ownership is the name on the registration certificate or on the stamped duplicate. All animals entered in the National Youth Show must be registered either in the name of the youth or in a family registration where the youth is also named.

ARRIVALS:Animals will be health-checked as they are unloaded.. You may unload between 8 AM and 10PM each day but please follow the times listed above on when you must be checked in by . DO NOT begin unloading until a show official is present.

PENS:The fee for pens will be \$8 per pen. All animals to be shown must be penned in the barn. Pens are 42” tall, 7 x 7 foot pens with vertical metal bars and concrete floors. 2-3 large breed or 3-4 miniature breed goats will comfortably fit in a pen. Please make sure to bring the necessary extras (ie: exercise panels, netting) for keeping small kids or jumpers in their pens. Please enter on the entry form the number of pens needed. Pens will be assigned. (IF wishing to be penned with someone else you MUST note this on your entry forms and accommodations will be made). No bedding will be included however there are local feed stores and an on-site vendor that sells bedding & feed.

TACK AREA: tack pens will be \$8/pen for the week, but there will also be plenty of room at the ends of the rows for some milk stands and others to be located. But please keep in mind that isles and rows need to be kept neat. And if you wish to have a bigger tack area you will want to get extra pens for that.

MILKOUT:There will be no mandatory pre-show milkouts. BUT, Please do not over udder your does. Please dispose of milk only in designated areas.

HEALTH RULES:All animals entered in the AGS National Show must meet Missouri Importation Health requirements. An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, signed by an accredited veterinarian, issued within 30 days of date of show, must accompany all animals. The certificate must list individual identification, a description of each animal, age, breed, and sex. All goats must be identified by registration numbers & tattoos. In addition, any goats originating in Canada must meet the USDA APHIS entry requirements.. Any animals appearing in poor health or displaying open abscesses or obvious signs of soremouth, ring-worm, or pinkeye may not be shown and will be quarantined to a designated area of the barn.

The show committee shall have the authority to request the quarantine of such an animal or have it to remain on the trailer. If quarantined there will be charges of \$8 for each pen needed.

PROGRAMS:1 program will come with each exhibitor's entries. Additional programs are available at \$5.00 each. Please enter the amount needed on the entry form and include the amount due with payment. Programs will also be available for purchase at the show.

ADS:If you would like an ad in the show program, business card size is \$10, 1/4 page for \$20, 1/2 page for \$40, and a full page for \$60.If you need to email an ad for the show book, please email: midwestcaprinecollective@gmail.com and place AGS Nationals Show Ad in the subject line. All ads must be received by May 25th.

CAMPING: Camping is available on the fairgrounds. Camping spots do not need to be reserved. Cost is \$18/night with full hook-up (electric, sewer, water). \$10/night for a tent/no hook-up. Missouri State Fairgrounds employees will collect fees. You may want to call ahead for prices the prices may have changed for the season.

ENTERTAINMENT:2 city swimming pools, miniature golf, go-carts, movie theaters, biking trails, parks and much more. We encourage you to get out and enjoy the "Show-Me" state.

PRIVATE TREATY: The American Goat Society and the National Show Committee accepts no responsibility for any private treaty sales. All sales activities are to be private transactions between the seller and buyer. Unless you have animals in the sale on June 6th. Then you must have all required testing performed as stated in that packet.**NOTE:** All animals, whether for show or for private treaty sales must be on the official health certificates to enter the barn and are subject to the same health standards as animals to be shown.

VET SERVICES:Information will be posted in the barn for area vets should you need one. All veterinarian charges must be negotiated between the veterinarian and the exhibitor. there will be State a veterinarians on site as well.

RAFFLE:There will be a national show raffle. Contact Nika Tipsword or Tamatha Gerkin, if you are interested in donating to the Raffle.

SILENT AUCTION: There will be a silent Auction for the event as well, if you wish to donate items (semen, buckets, leads, collars, AI equipment, etc) please contact Nika, Tammatha, Or Jennifer.

MISC: No smoking or open flame of any sort is permitted within any building. All exits shall remain free and clear at all times. Please keep the grounds and buildings clean. Used bedding to be disposed of in the designated area. Absolutely **no** dogs in the barn. The Best Western is a pet-friendly hotel so your canine companion is welcome to stay there. Please dress appropriately for the ring: the standard dress code of show whites or white shirt and black pants will be enforced.

1. AGS rules will Govern the AGS youth National Show 6/4/21 starting at 8am & AGS National Show 6/5/21 starting at 8am.
2. ADGA rules shall govern the ADGA/AGS dual sanctioned Shows.
3. The show order is subject to change at the Judge's and Show Chair's combined discretion
4. All Nigerians will be measured as they enter the ring. Over height animals will not be allowed to show.
5. NO DOGS allowed in the show area or in any area where goats are being housed, loaded, or unloaded. Service Dogs must be approved by the show committee prior to arrival, must have current and valid certification on person, you fully accept responsibility for any and all actions of owner & service animal. No Emotional Support Animals allowed. Failure to comply with this rule will result in removal from grounds.
6. It is expected that exhibitors respect the animals and property of others.
7. Parking will be in the designated parking area, no parking will be allowed right up next to the barn.
8. Standard Health Papers are required for in-state and out of state animals and animals must be in good health, **any animals with lumps or abscesses or otherwise ill in the opinion of the show committee, will not be allowed to show and will need to remain on trailer at all times and all show fees being forfeited for those animals.** Sick or injured goats will be asked to be kept on trailer. . For those of you crossing state lines be sure to satisfy any special requirements that might arise with your state, Check with your vet. We are not responsible for any actions that occur from failure to comply with your home state laws.

9. Exhibitors are responsible for providing current, original certificates for registration, and accuracy of any ROA. No photocopies, xerox copies, or print off copies will be accepted, this will result in the goats not able to show and all entry fees will not be returned.

10. AGS Classification will take place 6/4/21 during the day by Tim Flickinger.

11. Milk tests will be done for both ADGA & AGS. All Nigerians will be measured and recorded on the papers for milk testing. First milk out 6/2/21 7pm weight recorded, second milk out 7am /6/3/21 weight and sample taken, third milk out will be 7pm 6/3/21.
